Just two years after the horrific Shakahola tragedy shocked the nation, fresh mass graves have once again surfaced in nearby Kwa Bi Nzaro, yet in the midst of fear and deception, a quiet but powerful story of hope is unfolding.

Families in this vulnerable region are testifying that programs like "Neno Litaendelea" and "Jamvi La Gumzo" on SIFA FM have become their shield against false doctrines, guiding them into the truth of Scripture and literally saving lives.

In this newsletter, we bring you the compelling testimony of a listener whose faith, strengthened through Trans World Radio Kenya, helped him and his community stand firm while danger grew around them..

John's testimony shows that when God's Word is clearly taught, it reaches the forgotten, strengthens the vulnerable, and guards families from deception.

This is why gospel radio matters, because sometimes one broadcast is the difference between truth and tragedy.


